Open enrollment ends March 1, 2011. Applications are available in our office. Applications must be **pre-approved** by the District before removing any lawn. You have 6 months to complete your project. Turf removed must be living and maintained and at least 25% living plant coverage must be installed in the converted area. Non-permeable materials like plastic film and concrete do not qualify under this program. Only one application per site.
