Fire Dept. update - Call 911 for all emergencies. Only call the local office number if you have a question. All calls need to go through Dispatch for the fastest response time. If you do not have a home telephone please be aware of your location and be prepared to give it to Dispatch. If your house is secure, and to reduce damage to your home the Fire Dept. offers a secure program giving information on how to enter your home. Go to the Fire Dept. and give the Captain information on how to enter your home (ie. the location of a secret key or your garage door opener code) to reduce damage to your home. The information you give is sent to them over their pagers.
