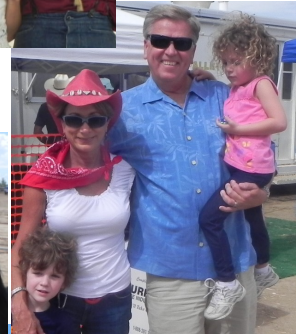

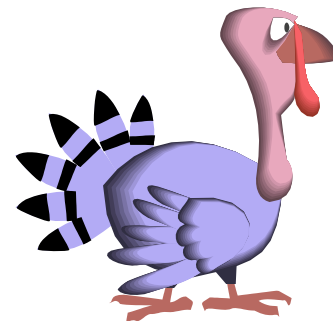


**Household Hazardous Waste** - 115 participants, 8,733 lbs. and 295 gallons (oil, etc.)
