- Turning off the water while brushing your teeth can save up to 8 gallons of water per day.


COMMUNITY FOOD WASTE DROP-OFF

We are now all required to handle food waste differently. California Senate Bill 1383 mandates that we decrease the amount of food waste that goes to the landfill.

Do I need a bag? Yes, you will need to put the food in a bag before you drop it in the bin. Please do not throw unbagged food in the bin.

What are the hours? For the convenience of our residents the food waste drop off will be available 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

Where do I bring my food waste? A food waste bin is located at the north end of the parking lot at the Community Center - 26540 Vista Rd.





The Community Food Waste Drop off program is off to a great start! Your participation helps the District meet State-mandated diversion requirements without adding a costly third barrel to your service.
