Save the Date – Fall Clean Up Day

Mark your calendar — October 28th from 8:00 am to 11:30 am we will be holding our annual fall clean up at the Community Center — 26540 Vista Rd. We will accept general trash, large items, electronic waste, green waste, and tires without rims (no commercial tires please).

Household Hazardous Waste

Residents may drop off antifreeze, batteries, oil and filters, paint, pesticides and fertilizers, fluorescent light bulbs and tubes, home generated needles, medicine (except controlled substances). Transport no more than 15 gallons or 125 lbs in containers no larger than 5 gallons. Containers must be sound and not leaking. Drop off location at the Community Center – 26540 Vista Rd. Helendale.

Community Food Waste Drop Off

We are now all required to handle food waste differently. California Senate Bill 1383 mandates that we decrease the amount of food waste that goes to the landfill.

Do I need a bag? Yes, the food must be in a bag before you drop it in the bin. Please do not throw unbagged food in the bin.

What are the hours? For the convenience of our residents, food waste drop off is available 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

Where do I bring my food waste? A food waste bin is located at the north end of the parking lot at the Community Center - 26540 Vista Rd.

What items are allowed? You can bring bones, bread, coffee, coffee filters, dairy, eggshells, expired food, food scraps, food soiled paper, fruit, meat, peels, seafood, and vegetables.

What's not allowed. Aluminum foil, bottles and cans, cooking oil, electronics, glass, green waste, hazardous waste, liquids, plastic, trash.

Tips for food waste recycling

- · Get a container
 - Countertop compost bin available for purchase at the CSD office for \$6



- Coffee Can
- Or another container with a lid
- Line your container with a plastic bag to keep the container clean and to make transporting food waste scraps easier
- Keep the container in a convenient place to make it easy to remember
- If you are throwing away expired food, remove it from packaging prior to bagging it
