Winterize Your Pipes

Before cold weather arrives, turn off your irrigation or water during the day, and know how to shut off your water by locating and checking your courtesy shut-off valve. Protect exposed pipes with insulation and open cabinet doors to allow warm air to circulate. If pipes freeze, immediately shut off the water before attempting to thaw them. As temperatures rise, pipes will thaw and water flow should return. When restoring water, turn it on slowly and inspect for leaks or cracks, shutting it off again if repairs are needed. Catalogs
Magazines, direct mail, catalogs.



Cardboard Tubes
Cardboard tubes from wrapping paper, paper towels and toilet paper.



Glass
Glass, bottles and jars - empty and rinsed out.



Aluminum and Steel
Aluminum foil, cans and cookware (cleaned).



Plastic Bottles and Tubs
Water and drink bottles, detergent bottles, yogurt, sour cream and other containers.
